- Apps not Browsers

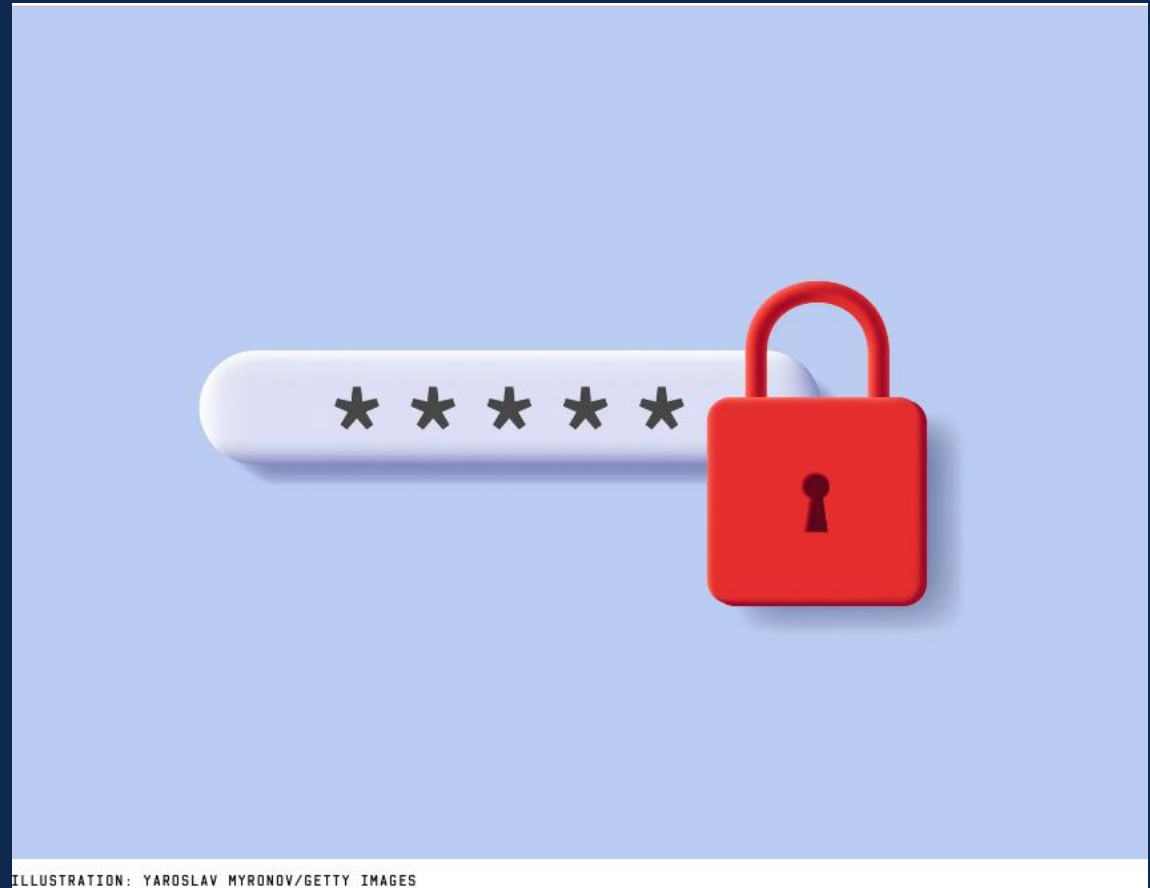

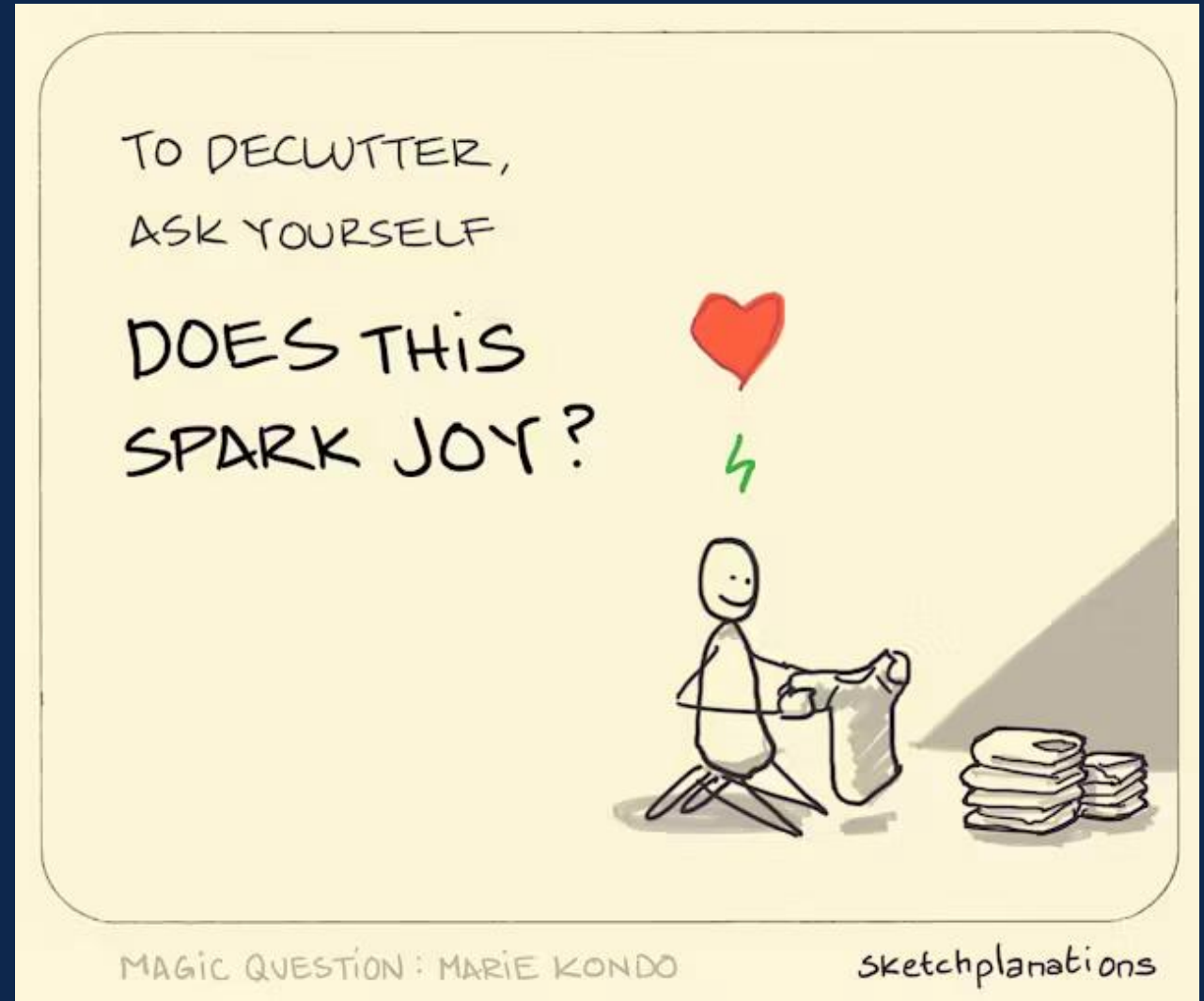

## Classification

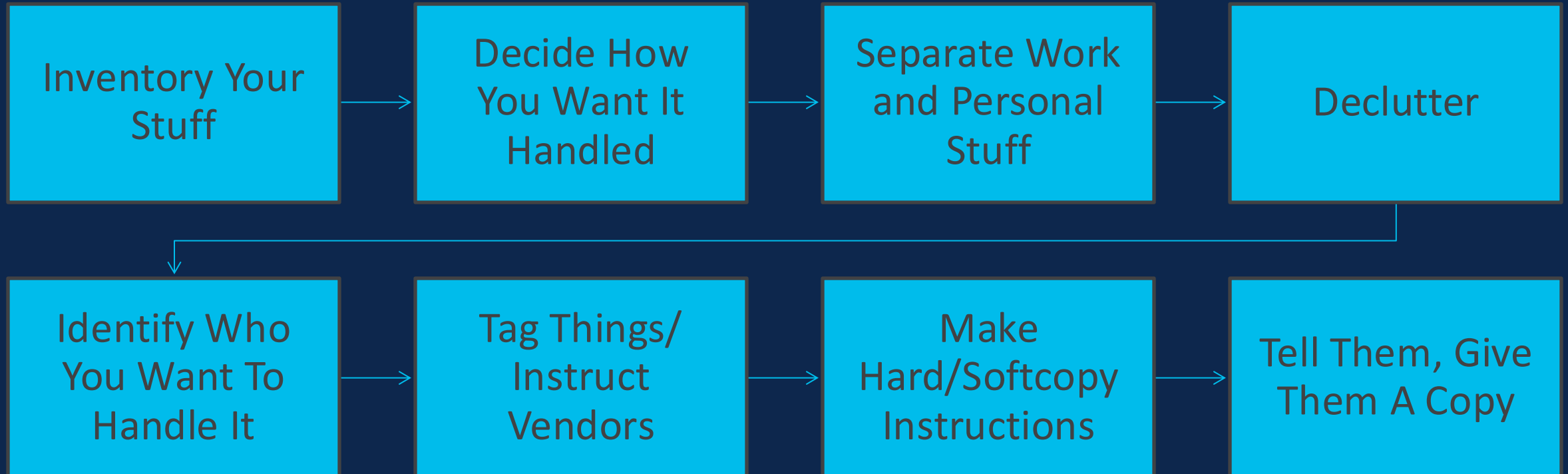
- Delete

- Digital Executor

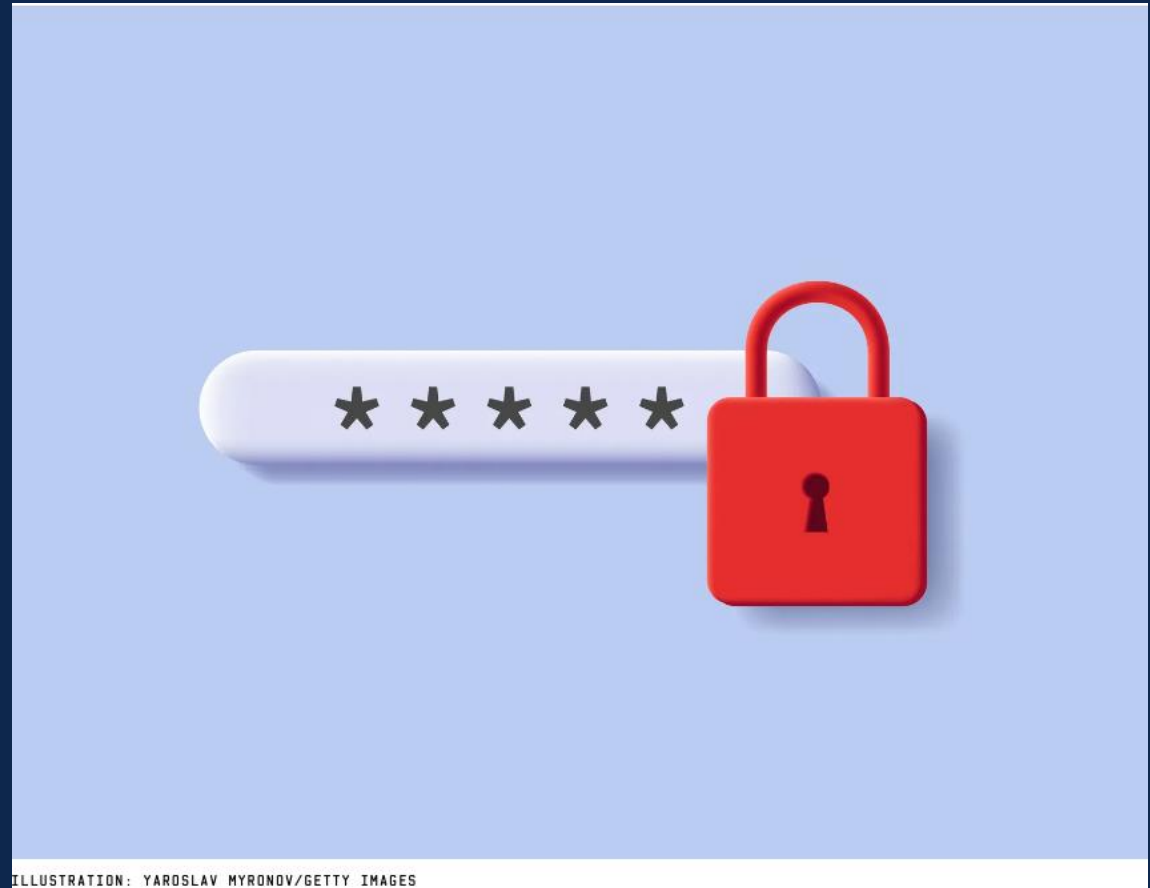

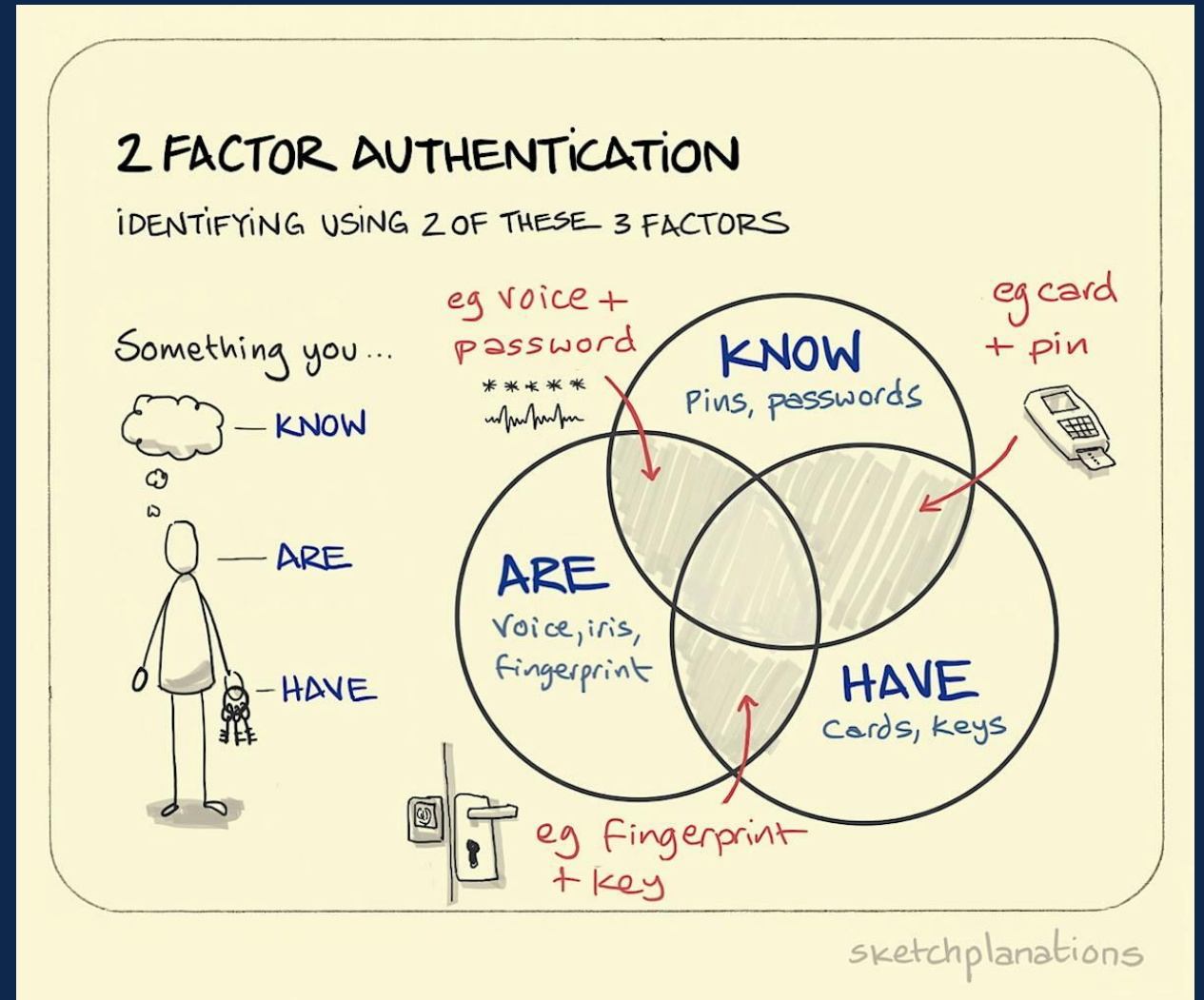
- Leave Instructions On How To Access and Use

# What's Next?

- Inventory your stuff
  - Get rid of anything you no longer need
  - Categorize/tag what remains
- Plan
  - Decide how you will share data/logins/etc.
  - Decide who you trust with your stuff
- Act
  - Enforce current security practices
  - Set up advance directives
  - Create instructions for person to manage your digital estate
- Repeat
  - Set reminders to check in and update plans every X months
  - Test backups and account access
